"Obviously, the state makes no sense," the author concludes, referring to Maryland's kaleidoscopic composition. Of course, that is precisely what makes this book interesting. From the tension between the wealthy gentry and regular folks of the Eastern shore to the independent-minded forgotten mountain people of Maryland's Appalachia, there is much to tell. Meyer easily mixes history with contemporary accounts of Chesapeake watermen, gambling, tobacco farms, military bases, the tunnel around Baltimore, race relations, etc. Some surprises are that many Amish live in Maryland and that whitewater rafting is controversial. However, the account of Annapolis is flippant and cynical, the author erroneously refers to a Marlboro County (nonexistent), and some portions are ordinary. Maps would have helped. Roger W.
